1.1. Nullam eu elit pulvinar

Nullam eu elit pulvinar, tincidunt dui sit amet, mollis lorem. Proin dictum dolor quis mollis accumsan. Vivamus quis feugiat metus (Hill, 2014).

Please use **no more than two level of headings**. Do not use two heading next to each other without text in-between.

For **direct quotation**, please use double quotation marks (“ ”). Always include the author, year, and page number as part of the citation.

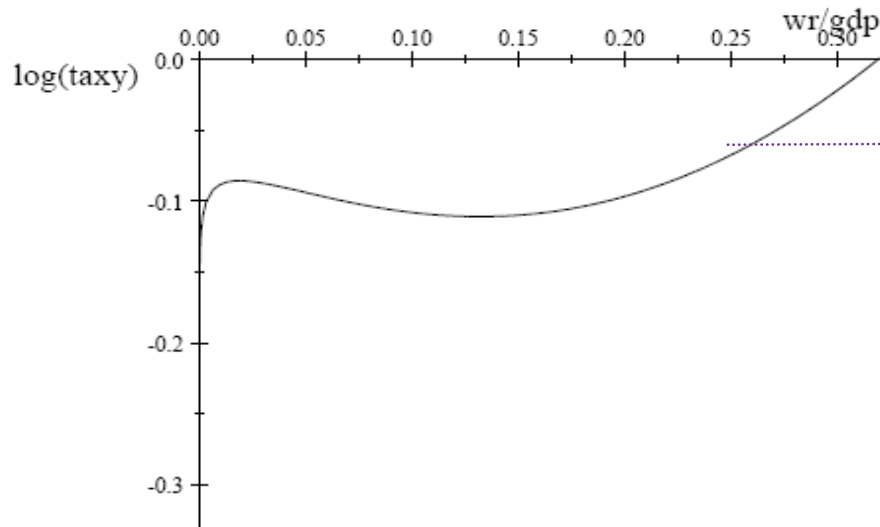
When a citation is used, source material must be documented in the body of the paper by citing the author(s) and year of the sources.

In sources with **more than 2 authors** the reference should be as in the example from text (first author’s surname **et al.**, year). In the reference list all authors must be listed.

Bullets & Numbering: use **simple lines** or **arab numbers**, TNR 11, Hanging: 0,63 cm.

A quotation with 40 or more words should be included in block format (without quotation marks) apart from the surrounding text – **indent: left & right 0.5 cm**.

Insert only word/excel graphs or jpg / png. formats (high-quality min. 300 dpi). For all the text in the figure use only TNR font.

All figures should have the width of the page.

Source: please indicate the source, TNR 10 pct

Kepp only simple and relevant tables within the text. Large tables should be included in an appendix at the end of the manuscript (whith counting starting from A1, A2...).

All tables should have the width of the page. Info inside tables should be written with TNR font. 10 pct.

Please indicate the source of data (Eurostat, World Bank, etc.)

Acknowledgements should be included at the end of the article before the references (not include them as a footnote to the title or otherwise).

The complete references list in accordance with the APA style is placed at the end of the paper, listed in alphabetical order. It should be **single spaced, TNR, size 10, hanging: 1 cm;**

Please consider the examples in the next section.

How to cite

General mandatory rules:

- All references included in the reference list should be cited in the text, and vice versa.
- **Non-English references shall be translated** between squared brackets.
- Arrange all sources alphabetically, not by format of publication (book, journal, etc.)
- DOI's - if available, **always add a DOI** to the end of print or online resources in your reference lists, include full link:

Eastern Journal of European Studies use citation rules in accordance with the APA style: the Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association, Seventh Edition (2020).

Citation in text

Source with one author:	Smith (2013, p. 52) indicate that... or (Smith, 2013, p. 52)
Source with two authors:	Smith and Danson (2013, p. 52) indicates that... or (Smith & Danson 2012, p. 52)
Source with more than two authors:	(Smith et al., 2013)
Two or more works in the same citation (alphabetically , then cronologically):	Several authors prove that... (Danson, 2013; Smith et al., 2013; Wiley, 2010; 2014)
